

Welcome to the European SuzukiTM Association (ESA) approved Teacher Training course to become a SuzukiTM violin teacher.

Autumn 2019 - Spring 2020

The Norwegian Suzuki Association will organize a Suzuki teacher training course for violinists in Oslo, Level 1 or Level 2, with Martin Rüttimann as the Teacher Trainer. Higher levels will also be offered if there are enough participants.

Prospective trainees should ideally have an internationally approved professional music degree in the violin or demonstrate an equivalent standard of playing and musical education, and who would like to become a SuzukiTM Teacher or continue their SuzukiTM Teacher Training.

SuzukiTM Teacher Training consists of 5 units, each lasting a year. Each unit concludes with an examination whereby the trainee performs pieces from the syllabus, teaches children and takes part in a short interview. The curriculum focuses on Suzuki philosophy, instrumental performance, pedagogy, history, and repertoire for Level 1 or 2 in Suzuki violin books 1 or 2. It is a requirement that trainees observe other qualified Suzuki teachers during the course year prior to the exam. For details, please refer to ESAs TT manual page 21-22:

Upon passing Level 1, trainees will be awarded an internationally recognized SuzukiTM Teachers certificate and the right to use the title, SuzukiTM Teacher, which is a protected title. This is a unique extension of the teacher's pedagogic and music education.

The course will take place over 6 weekends, and the final exam will held during the Norwegian Suzuki Association's summer workshop at Geilo in June 2020.
